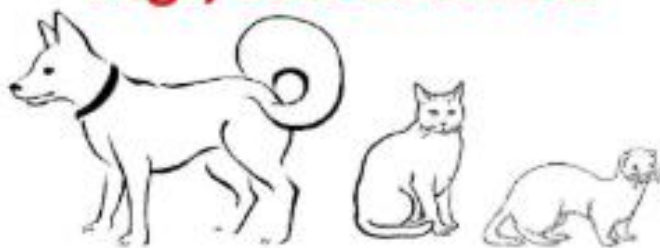




Information for travelers traveling with dogs, cats & ferrets



The animals must have:

1. AN INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFICATION



2. A VALID ANTI-RABIES VACCINATION



3. AN IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENT



4. * AN APPROPRIATE RESULT OF RABIES ANTIBODY TITRATION TEST



5. * A PROPER TREATMENT AGAINST ECHINOCOCCUS MULTILOCULARIS

The identification document of the animal for movement within the European Union is correctly and completely filled in the [EU PASSPORT](#).

For travel outside the EU, the requirements of the third country additionally apply (for more information, please contact the relevant diplomatic establishment or consular institution).

CAUTION! BEFORE LEAVING THE EU, ALSO CHECK THE RETURN REQUIREMENTS THO THE EU!

The EU passport allows to return to the EU, provided that all necessary information is completed in the document before leaving the EU territory and that the anti-rabies vaccination remains still valid. In all other cases, [the HEALTH CERTIFICATE](#) issued by an official veterinarian of third country will be an identification document.
